Deborah Peacock Appointed to New Mexico Environmental Improvement Board (February 2011)

Governor Susana Martinez has appointed Deborah Peacock to the New Mexico Environmental Improvement Board ("EIB"), subject to Senate confirmation. The EIB consists of seven members appointed by the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate. In announcing the new appointments, Governor Martinez said the EIB should implement "common-sense environmental regulations" that won't stifle economic growth.

The New Mexico Environmental Improvement Board ("EIB") is responsible for the enactment of rules and standards in food protection, water supply, liquid waste, air quality management, radiation control, noise control, nuisance abatement, occupational health and safety, sanitation of public swimming pools and public baths, plumbing, drainage, ventilation and sanitation of public buildings, medical radiation, health and safety certification and standards for radiologic technologists, hazardous wastes and petroleum storage tanks and solid waste.
