This annular solar eclipse will take place on May 20, 2012, with the maximum coverage occurring in New Mexico just after 7:30 p.m. Mountain Time. It will be the first annular eclipse in North America since the solar eclipse of May 10, 1994. An annular eclipse occurs when the moon covers most of the sun's disk leaving a thin ring of light around the edge appearing as a "ring of fire."
